



#### Number of Child Protective Services Cases (includes Investigations and Family Preservation cases)





#### Recurrence of Substantiated Child Maltreatment (Dec 2012 – Dec 2013)





#### Number of Child Placement Services Cases (December 2013)





Number of Children in the Custody and Care of DFCS (December 2013)




#### Children in the Legal Custody of DFCS Under the Age of 18 (December 2012 - December 2013)



#### Extended Youth Services (December 2012 - December 2013)


Def: Number of children age 18 and over who have signed themselves back into care.






#### Comparison of Foster Care Entries and Exits (December 2012 - December 2013)

Def: Of all children in DFCS custody, the percentage that are placed with a relative or relative foster home.
